H.O.M.E. Content Policy

Since H.O.M.E. is a Christian organization, we strive to make sure that the atmosphere that we create at H.O.M.E. events is glorifying to God. To make sure that we provide this atmosphere, all items brought to co-op and all other H.O.M.E. events and activities should reflect a Christian or neutral stand point. This includes but is not limited to the following items: backpacks, notebooks, pencils, show and tell items, clothes, jewelry, hats and other such items. The H.O.M.E. Board recognizes that there are a lot of gray area as to what is acceptable and what goes against the Bible. While we don't desire to offend anyone, we also want to be sensitive to our families and more importantly, to God's heart. The H.O.M.E. Board has created a policy that items portraying content in the following areas are to be left at home:

witchcraft, Astrology, anything to do with psychic phenomenon, skulls not in relation to the human body, spellcasting, ghosts, or any other content that might be anti-Biblical in content. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in this matter.

Holiday Policy

We are a co-op of Christian families, yet we all have difference stances on events such as Halloween and the secular parts of holidays like Christmas (Santa) and Easter (Easter bunny) and other such areas (Tooth Fairy, etc.). We want to make sure that we do not offend those who desire to have these areas as a part of their lives nor others who choose to refrain from incorporating these areas into their families' lives. Therefore, we ask members of co-op to stay away from doing any projects that involve Halloween emblems, Santa Claus, Easter Bunny, Tooth Fairy, and the like. We want to be sensitive to the families who do not want their children to have these areas introduced to them. At the same time, our policy is not intended to offend those who do believe in these various areas. There are many other areas that we can focus on at our meetings without broaching these controversial subjects. Thank you so much for your cooperation in this matter!
